ALL COMPETITORS MUST COMPLETE AND SEND SIGNED FORM**General Information & Conditions of Entry**

1. Entry Form must be completed honestly, accurately, legibly and SIGNED.
2. Use only one entry form per person.
3. **To be eligible competitors must hold a ranking no higher than 1st Kyu. Black Belts and above are ineligible.**
4. **AGE IS DETERMINED BY THE AGE A COMPETITOR WILL BE ON 17 September 2010**
5. If under 18 years of age, entry forms must be signed by **both Parents or Guardians.**
6. WKF (World Karate Federation) rules will be applied to this tournament and modified at the discretion of the organisers.
7. Most events in the Kyu Grade tournament will be officiated using the Mirror System.
8. Competitors are responsible for their own Public Liability & Professional Indemnity Insurance including Participation (Member to Member) & Sports Injury/Accident cover.
9. The organisers reserve the right to combine or cancel divisions where there are insufficient entries.
10. Athletes 35 - 45 years of age may compete in both Veterans and Senior individual divisions.
11. **Athletes 45 years and over must obtain a medical clearance and such clearance attached to entry form.**
12. **Only NCAS qualified coaches will be permitted in the competition area and all coaches must wear club/state tracksuit. Coaches Registration Form must be completed and returned to the AKF National Coaching Director no later than Wednesday 10 March 2010.**
13. **It is an AKF Inc. condition of entry that any competing athlete or attending coach is NOT under any current or existing performance enhancing drug sanctions from WADA or the relative agency/s of the country of origin of the competing athlete or attending coach.**

Kumite (2 minute bouts)**COMPULSORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

1. Groin Guards (Males) and Mouthguards and WKF/AKF approved red and blue Mitts – All competitors.
2. WKF/AKF approved red and blue combined Shin/Instep Protectors – All competitors.
3. WKF/AKF approved chest protection (Females – Juniors, Seniors & Veterans)
4. WKF approved face masks - Cadets (14 & 15 years) and ALL Children (9 - 13 years)
5. WKF/AKF approved body protectors - Cadets (14 & 15 years) and ALL Children (9 - 13 years)

Kata

1. **Free choice Kata. Must have minimum two Kata. May repeat but not in consecutive rounds.**
