- Open Australian Open
- National Championships
- Oceania Championships

Attend and participate in the following events in 2012:

- All National Squad Training Sessions relevant to your respective competition discipline High Performance Camp
WKF Training Camp

KUMITE

Win the following events in 2012:

- Sydney International Karate Championships
- Australian Open
- National Championships
- Oceania Championships
- WKF Karate1 Premier League - German Open

Attend and participate in the following events in 2012:

- All National Squad Training Sessions relevant to your respective competition discipline High Performance Camp
WKF Training Camp

An athlete's election will not be GUARANTEED if they do not achieve the above, however their performance at the above events as well as their performance at other International Events (endorsed by the AKF) will be taken into consideration when the AKF selects the Team.

Where participation in the above events are subject to a Team Selection Criteria an athlete must meet such criteria, be selected into the relevant team and participate at that event.
